



Cost of Attendance for United College Students at Drake in Des Moines

The cost listed is “all inclusive”, meaning that it includes tuition, fees, on-campus housing and food, mandatory health insurance, an estimate of round-trip airfare between China and Des Moines, and an estimate of the student’s personal miscellaneous expenses in Des Moines during the school year.

Note that United College students can also apply for a need-based International Student Tuition Grant which, if eligible, can potentially reduce the student’s direct cost by as much as \$3,000/year.
